Don't think you're eligible for financial help through Vermont Health Connect?

The American Rescue Plan Act, signed into law on March 11th, has health insurance changes for 2021-2022:

- ✓ **HIGHER INCOME LIMITS**
If you made too much money to get financial help in the past, you may be able to get financial help this year as long as you're enrolled in a qualified health plan through Vermont Health Connect.
- ✓ **MORE PREMIUM TAX CREDITS**
Vermonters who get premium tax credits will likely get more, so your monthly bill from Vermont Health Connect may go down. You can also choose to get the entire tax credit when you file federal taxes.

We'll post the latest news to this page, including how to apply, financial help estimates, and updates for Vermonters who got unemployment benefits in 2021.

Now through May 14, 2021 Vermonters without health insurance have a Special Enrollment Period to get Vermont Health Connect coverage.
